Silent Vows

Monk – Male, any age but should be similar in age to Nun.

Nun – Female, any age.

A park bench in summer, any time. Park sound effects, birds, leaves etc.

The following meeting should be taken slow, without dragging, and in a general air of serenity.

(Monk is sitting alone in the centre of the park bench, eyes closed, contemplating, enjoying the warm sun on his face. He is very calm.)

Monk: (Opens he eyes, looks to the sky and smiles, closes his eyes.)

Nun: (Enters, walks slowly towards the bench. Stops and waits.)

Monk: (Remains seated, eyes closed.)

Nun: (Steps into Monks light so he appears to be in Nuns shadow from the sun.)

Monk: (Slowly becomes aware the sun has gone in, opens one eye to see Nun, smiles, opens his other

eye.)

Nun: (Steps to one side, smiles down at Monk.)

Monk: (Smiles in return, gently shuffles to one side of the bench.)

Nun: (Smiles, nods slightly and sits down next to Monk, leaving a respectful gap.)

Monk: (Looks to Nun.)

Nun: (Looks back, slightly)

Monk: (Lifts his head up slightly, closes his eyes.)

Nun: (Gently shakes her head. Closes her eyes.)

Monk: (opens one eye slowly to look at Nun.)

Nun: (Breathes in deeply, her shoulders raise and fall.)

Monk: (Opens both eyes, still looking at Nun.)

Nun: (Lifts her head so her face is in the sun.)

Monk: (Smiles at Nun.)

Nun: (Turns her head, opens her eyes and smiles back at Monk.)

Monk: (Puts his finger to his lips and 'zips' them.)

Nun: (Nods gently. Raises her eyebrows.)

Monk: (Nods gently in agreement.)

Nun and Monk: (Look forward and serenely smile.)
